If you are dropping off entries instead of staying to enter them, make sure box or container has exhibitor name and exhibitor # on the outside of the box.

If you are interested in express check in you may drop off his/her box or tote at Thompson Hall on Saturday, August 17th from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. (earlier cut off for those dropping items to allow workers time to enter before 4 p.m.) or enter as in previous years and wait until all items are entered in each area.
