

Washington County Fair 2020 Virtual Rabbit Show

Due to social distancing from Covid 19 and the spreading of Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Virus (RHDv2), the Washington County fair will host a virtual rabbit show on Facebook. This will be a youth only show.

- All recognized breeds, meat pens, single fryers, and doe with litter accepted
- No pet show
- No showmanship competition
- No beautiful bunny contest
- LIMIT 6 ENTRIES PER EXHIBITOR
- Judging is based on the Standards of Perfection for Rabbits and Cavies

Dates

- Paper entries due August 1, 2020
- Virtual entries accepted August 1 – August 16
- Virtual entries close at 9pm August 16
- Virtual judging August 17 – August 21
- All results posted August 24
- MEAT PENS AND SINGLE FRYERS
 - Must include a photo of entry on the scales for proof of weight
 - Weigh-in and photo August 25 from 8am – noon at the Livestock arena at fairgrounds
 - One exhibitor/family at scales at one time
 - Wait in vehicle until scales are available
 - Market entries without weight photo will be disqualified
 - No special tattoo needed to market classes

How to Enter

- Log in on Facebook
- Accept the invite to Washington County Fair 2020 Virtual Rabbit Show
- Look for the breed to be entered
- Post a collage picture of that breed under the correct age and gender in the comments
- Label entry with exhibitors name

Pictures for Judging

- Pose rabbit to be judged
- Take pictures. Include a side view, hindquarters, top, head, and all markings on marked breeds, wool on wool breeds, and legible tattoo.
- Avoid covering the rabbits head so as not to alter appearance
- No photo shopped or excessively edited pictures or entry may be disqualified
- Collage the pictures and post with exhibitors name
- Running breeds must include a short video of the rabbit running to judge movement

All eligible FFA and 4-H youth must name the Facebook account that they will enter under in order to be invited to the private Facebook group. Email me if you have questions at n.kirkner@yahoo.com
