A \$500.00 scholarship will be given to a qualified 4-H, FFA, or FCCLA member. The winner will be announced at 5:00 pm, Friday at the awards program in the Livestock Arena. The recipient should be present to claim the scholarship.

Requirements

- *Must be a high school senior or college freshman planning to attend a school of higher education in the Agriculture field. Applicant may attend a 2 or 4 year school.
- *Must have exhibited at least 3 years at the Washington County Fair.
- *Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- *Must participate in an interview with selection committee (Applicant will be notified of the time and place for interview)
- *Cannot win scholarship more than once.

The selection committee will be appointed by the Fair Board. The following point system will help determine scholarship winner:

- 5 Each yr. exhibited at WCF (Max 40 points)
- 5 Each year GPA is above 3.0 (9-12 grades)
- 0-20 Financial need

(Taking into consideration scholarship already received)

- Each division exhibited in at WCF (up to 20 points)
- *One-half of the scholarship (\$250.00) will be paid at the end of the first semester and one-half at the end of the second semester upon the Fair Board receiving a transcript showing the recipient maintained a 2.5 GPA for the semester. Request for scholarship money must be made to Washington County Fair Board, attn.: Cheryl West, no later than the end of their freshman year.
